

## **Community Health Interprofessional Challenge (CHIC) Sponsors**

**NEOMED students and recent NEOMED faculty (basic science or clinical)**

**SPONSOR: NEOMED Office of Faculty and Relations and Professional Development**

### **Eligibility**

- Teams members must consist of at least four NEOMED students and 1 recent NEOMED faculty (basic science or clinical) no more than 5 years from their healthcare degree graduation date. Students must represent at least two different degree programs.
- All five team members must be a NEOMED student or faculty/ member.

### **Award**

- First place—each team member will receive a \$100 Amazon gift card

**NEOMED students**

**SPONSORS: NEOMED Office of Diversity and Inclusion and Northeast Ohio Area Health Education Center Program**

### **Eligibility**

- All team members must be NEOMED students
- At least one student must be from a Health Professions Shortage Area (HPSA) or Medically Underserved Area (MUA) or attended Health Careers in Progress (HIP). The shortage/underserved area will be determined by looking at the address of home residence located on the <http://bhpr.hrsa.gov/shortage/> website.
- Teams must have gender diversity representation (e.g. male and female).

**Undergraduate students from The University of Akron, Cleveland State University, Kent State University, or Youngstown State University**

**SPONSOR: Northeast Ohio Area Health Education Center Program**

### **Eligibility**

- All team members must consist of students who are undergraduates from the consortium universities in northeast Ohio (The University of Akron, Cleveland State University, Kent State University, or Youngstown State University). Students must also come from a northeast Ohio county: Ashland, Ashtabula, Carroll, Columbiana, Crawford, Cuyahoga, Geauga, Holmes, Lake, Lorain, Mahoning, Medina, Portage, Richland, Stark, Summit, Trumbull, Tuscarawas, and Wayne counties.
- Students should have an interest in behavioral health, cultural competency, current health issues, interprofessional education, and social determinants of health.

### **Awards**

### **Health Scholars Program Students**

**SPONSOR: Education for Service (EFS) Health Professions Affiliation Communities (HPAC) Scholars Program**

#### **Eligibility**

- Teams members must be Health Scholars college year one and two students from Cleveland State University, Baldwin Wallace University, Hiram College, and Youngstown State University. Potentially be high school students or medical students that are participating in collaboration with the health scholar's students

#### **Awards**
