Springboard (now BrightSpace)—Getting Started

Obtaining your password

Either the MPH office or someone from Springboard will email your UANet ID to you. You will need to obtain your password. IF YOU ARE A STUDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF AKRON: You should already have your UANet ID, which was listed under your name in your UA letter of admissions; it would also be on your Zip card, if you got one. If you do not have your UANet ID, contact the Akron Zip Support Center at 330-972-6888, and tell them your student ID.

- Call The University of Akron Zip Support Center at 330-972-6888 to get your password by giving them the UANet ID that the CEOMPH office will provide to you. The University of Akron's Zip Support Center is open Monday through Thursday from 7:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.; Friday 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 pm; and Saturday/Sunday from 12 noon to 4:00 p.m. at 330-972-6888.
- If you log on is successful, you should see your core course on your home page—however, they will not open until the first day of class!

Checking for computer compatibility

To verify that your computer and web browser meet the necessary requirements for Springboard, you can perform a system check here: <https://springboard.uakron.edu/d2l/systemCheck>. Please note that depending on the type of content that is present in your courses, you may need additional software to access it (Adobe Flash, Real Player, Quicktime, etc.).

Access your courses

- Enter your User name (your ID) and password.
- You should see the MPH program core courses in which you are registered starting *on the first day of classes*. If you do not see your courses, please contact Amy Lee, 330-325-6164 or email pubhlth@neomed.edu.

Navigation bar (under the course title and Springboard logo)

- *Course home*—the page that contains the course announcements, updates and calendar.
- *Course materials*—you will find MOST of the course materials in the content section. Lectures, resources and other materials will be posted here.
- *Assessments*—the assignment folder, grades, quizzes and exams are the most commonly used items here.
- *Discussion*—some of the MPH core courses will use the discussions as assignments, some do not. If you want to start your own forum to open a discussion with your classmates, go ahead!
- *Communication*—you will find the class list (where you can check out your classmates' profiles) and discussion forums here. Although you can contact people in the class from this section, it is best to email faculty at the email address posted in the syllabus—do not try to email faculty through Springboard (some are provided UA IDs that would connect with a UA email address—we cannot access these emails since most of us are not UA faculty!).

Tips

- If you have questions on how to “do” things in Springboard, you can contact us in the MPH office at 330-325-6179 or pubhlth@neomed.edu! If we cannot help you right away, then we will find your answer! Don't forget to click on the “help” section in Springboard first!
- If your password does not work, contact The University of Akron Zip Support Center at 330-972-6888 to get your password by giving them your UANet ID. Sometime passwords expire!
- Download items from the “content” section that seem to be running slowly (e.g., narrated PowerPoints) onto your hard-drive. Once you download them (it may take a while!), you should be able to access them quicker if they are on your hard-drive.
- **Make sure you have Adobe Reader, Adobe Flash, Real Player, and Window Media Player** (all free downloads) on your computer.
